 - 1 Vulgar language

 - 3 No broadcasting of someone's personal information in an effort to discredit them or embarrass them
 - 4 Content/comments off topic
 - 5 Spam
 - 6 Links to sites that contain offensive material or attack on a person
 - 7 Promotion of service, products, political organizations/agendas
 - 8 Information that is factually incorrect
